

# 2023 OREGON MIDDLE SCHOOL WRESTLING BOYS STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

*Wrestlers qualify for boys state by placing at any of the regional qualifiers.*

DATE: Saturday, March 11<sup>th</sup> - Doors open 7:30 AM for girls; **wrestling starts for boys at 12:00 PM.**

ADMISSION: **\$5 entry fee for coaches and spectators** (under 6 are free)

REGISTRATION: **\$25 per wrestler**, payable at weigh-ins (write checks to "Woodburn Wrestling"). Wrestlers participate under assigned middle school, not club. **School ID required.** If school does not issue an ID, print some proof of enrollment with student grade level (e.g. report card). Homeschoolers can bring comparable verification of grade. They will register under the middle school they would have been assigned to attend. Only open to current 6-8 graders.

WEIGH-INS: Friday, March 10<sup>th</sup> from 4:00-7:00 7PM at Woodburn High School (gym is located in back of school). OSAA rules for weigh-ins are in effect. Wrestlers will **weigh-in wearing approved uniforms** (singlet or compression shirt with shorts). There are no check scales and absolutely no weight cutting at the facility or leaving the weigh-in area once you enter. OSAA *Medical Release for Wrestlers to participate with Skin Lesion* is required to compete if wrestler does not pass skin checks.

WEIGHTS: 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 102, 110, 117, 125, 132, 140, 150, 160, 175, 195, 220, 275

SEEDING: <sup>1</sup>Champions from each regional qualifier will be seeded 1-4 based on <sup>2</sup>previous place at the middle school state tournament and <sup>3</sup>total points scored at regionals.

FORMAT: 16-man brackets with state qualifiers pulled from each regional as follows:

**6 from Willamette, 4 from Central, 3 from Eastern, and 3 from Southern**

During the tournament, no changes will be made to the brackets to avoid teammates or previous opponents. Top 6 placers at state receive medals. There will be 4 team trophies. Awards will be presented at the podium at the end of the tournament.

COACHES PASSES: Coach's wrist bands will be passed out at the coaches meeting based on the number of qualifiers from each middle school.

OFFICIALS: OSAA certified officials will be at the tournament.

OTHER INFO:

- Headgear is required and shoelaces must be secured. Long hair must be secured with either rubber bands or proper hair covering secured to headgear.
- Only two coaches can be in the corner; no other spectators allowed matside.
- Nobody should block the view by standing or sitting along the front of the mat (even if recording a match). They will need to sit in the bleachers.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct by any individual may result in immediate removal from the premises and possible removal of the head coach. Coaches encourage good sportsmanship from parents.
- Concessions and tournament shirts and hoodies will be available for purchase.
